About Us

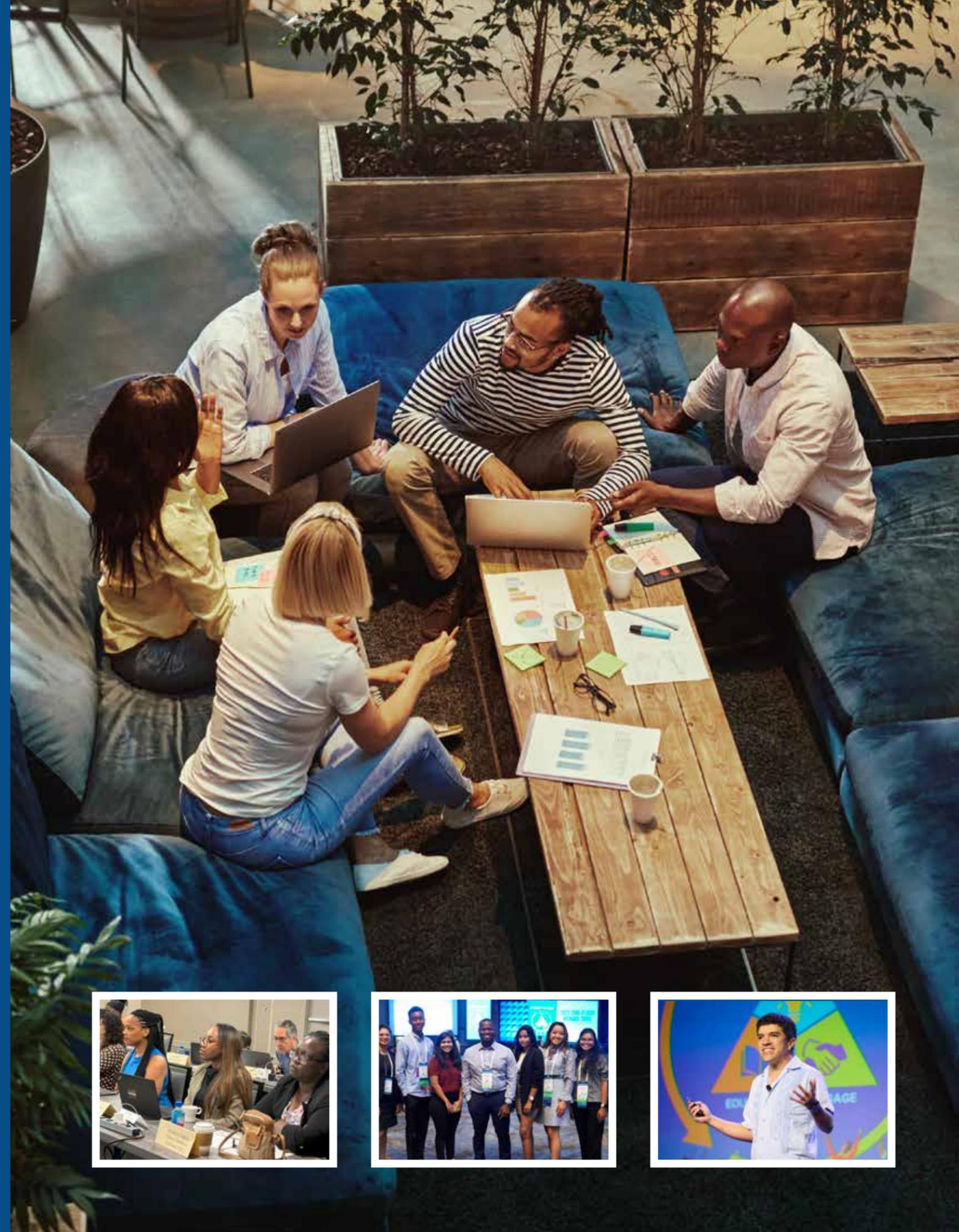

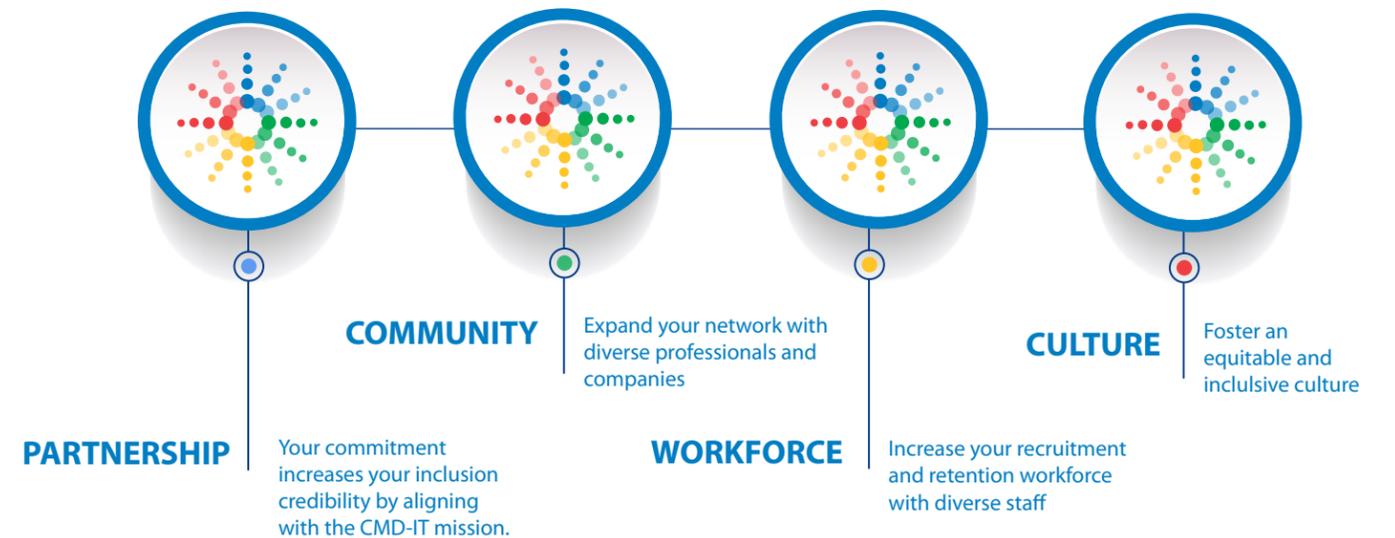

Tapia Conference

The CMD-IT/ACM Richard Tapia Celebration of Diversity in Computing Conference is the premier venue to acknowledge, promote and celebrate diversity in computing. The goal of the Tapia Conference is to bring together undergraduate and graduate students, faculty, researchers, and professionals in computing from all backgrounds and ethnicities.

The conference offers the following opportunities for CMD-IT Partners, beyond regular sponsorship:

LEAP Alliance

The LEAP (Diversifying Future LEAdership in the Professoriate) Alliance addresses the broadening participation challenge of increasing the diversity of the future leadership in the professoriate in computing at research universities as a way to achieve diversity across the field. The LEAP Alliance includes four cohorts of universities, with two cohorts focused on increasing diversity of the doctoral program in computing, one cohort focused on increasing exposure to academia, and one cohort focused on increasing the retention of baccalaureate graduates in computing from CMD-IT's target communities. The LEAP Alliance offers the following opportunities for CMD-IT Partners:

Access to domestic doctoral students in computing from CMD-IT's target communities from 30 institutions

Access to undergraduate students in computing from CMD-IT's target communities at institutions that historically have students that go to graduate school

Increasing Diversity of Future Leadership.



Student Professional Development Workshop

The Student Professional Development Workshop provides undergraduate and masters level computer science students with the unique opportunity to receive coaching and development from industry and government professionals about the job application, interview processes and resume writing skills. The workshops are held at the Tapia Conference and generally consists of 300 students (constrained by the room), with at least a hundred students on the wait list. CMD-IT Partners are given the following unique opportunities:

First opportunity to serve on the two panels – one focused on effective resumes and one focused on advancing the interview skills

An opportunity to give a five-minute welcome to participants

First opportunity to participate as resume reviewers to provide advice on effective resumes tailed for your company



Tailored Webinars

CMD-IT offers monthly webinars to our diverse communities, for which our Partners have the unique opportunity to have webinars tailored to your topics of interest. The number of tailored webinars is determined by the level of support. We also provide the contact information of registrants who agree to have their information released.

Academic Careers Workshop

The Academic Careers Workshop mentors assistant and associate level faculty and senior doctoral students from CMD-IT's target communities about the academic career ladder. The workshop includes panels of diverse senior faculty talking about the tenure and promotion process, launching a research program, effective teaching, and a detailed session on proposal writing.

In addition, the workshop includes a discussion about alternative career paths, which provides an excellent opportunity for CMD-IT partners to engage with participants.



University Award

The CMD-IT University Award for Retention of Minorities and Students with Disabilities in Computer Science recognizes US institutions that have demonstrated a strong commitment to increasing the computer science baccalaureate degree production of minorities and students with disabilities, through effective retention programs.

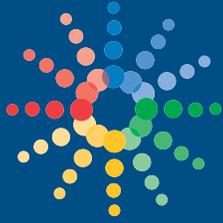
